MEMBERSHIP :

Lions Clubs International (LCI) has identified membership growth as the main indicator for the success and effectiveness of the District.

October is the month focused on membership growth. Our district could adopt certain strategies to ensure continued and sustained growth as follows:

'0' Weak Clubs : LCI considers clubs with less than 20 members as 'weak clubs'. It is our district goal to ensure that by the end of this fiscal year there are no 'weak clubs' in District 308B1. I therefore appeal to all clubs with less than 20 members to focus on initiatives to increase membership to ensure membership crosses the magic figure of 20 members per club, or even better, at least 25 members per club.

Let us focus our activities to seek out able Malaysians who are willing to serve among those around us. LCI awards an October Membership Banner Patch to every club that brings in new members to the club. It is my hope that this year every club in our district will qualify for this award.

Several other possible sites have been identified by our Club Extension Chairman, Dr. Ding Liang Hock. Here's wishing all clubs the very best in this venture.

Family and Women's Membership Development, the number of women joining the Lions is encouraging. This is good news. Please keep up the good work.

LIONS EYE CLINIC :

The site for the clinic at MAHSA College, Jalan Universiti, Kuala Lumpur was visited by a team of senior Lions including Past District Governors and found to be satisfactory. The Chairman of MAHSA, Dato' Prof Dr. Mohd Haniffa very generously pledged free use of his space as well as an annual grant of RM100,000.00 towards the clinic. Hearing Impaired Awareness Day
Regions 3 & 4 Project on Hearing, Speech and Work with the Deaf,
incorporating Crime Prevention.

There will be a Project involving the Hearing Impaired, the Public, the Lions, Lioness, Leos, Teachers of the Hearing Impaired, the Police and Sponsors.

The objective of this project is to bring awareness to the public about the hearing impaired and how we can communicate with them. This will create a better understanding with the Hearing Impaired.

At the same time, there will also be a crime prevention talk by the Police, again another awareness programme for the public.

Activities for the project

- A 3 hour Hand Sign Language course for those who are interested to learn the language so that they can communicate better with the Hearing Impaired.
- A 30 minutes Crime Prevention Talk by PDRM.
- A 30 minutes Talk on Hearing Care by Clarisound Professional Hearing Care.
- A free of charge Hearing Screening Test
