LIONS ENVIRONMENTAL PHOTO CONTEST

The Lions Environmental Photo Contest provides a way for Lions to portray, through an original photo, their pride and commitment to improving, protecting and preserving their environment. In line with the above objective, Multiple District 308 will be organizing a Joint Lions Environmental Photo Contest. This is the first time that the Multiple District has decided to organise the Lions Environmental Photo Contest jointly. The contest is opened to the public but all entries must be endorsed by a Lions Club in the Multiple District. The rules and conditions for participation in the Joint Lions Environmental Photo Contest are as follows:-

1. Closing dates for the contest will be on **15 January 2011**. No late entries will be entertained. All photos must be submitted to PDG Lion Dato Dr Foo Wan Kien, the Multiple District Environmental Chairman at this address:

2. The size of the printed photograph must be 8" x 10" (20.3 x 25.4 cm). The winning contestants for the top three prizes will be required to submit a soft copy of the photograph on a CD. The CD and photograph will not be returned.
3. All entries must meet the criteria set out by LCI. There will be 5 categories:
 - a. Animal Life
 - b. Landscape (urban or natural)
 - c. Plant life
 - d. Weather phenomenon

- e. Protecting our future with trees (Photos of trees and the vital roles they play in our communities)

• **Photos submitted must not have people. Failure to adhere to this ruling may result in the photo being disqualified.**


4. Contestants must state the category that they are entering for the photograph submitted by them. However, each contestant will only be permitted to win only ONE of the top 3 prizes.
5. Photographs that have won any other contests or have been published in magazines and newspapers are not eligible. We define winning as having won a grand prize or 1st, 2nd, or 3rd place overall.
6. By entering the contest, entrants grant the Lions Clubs International District 308 (MD308) and Lions Clubs International (LCI) a royalty-free, worldwide, perpetual, non-exclusive license to display, distribute, reproduce and create derivative works of the entries, in whole or in part, in any media now existing or subsequently developed, for any educational, promotional, publicity, exhibition, archival, scholarly and all other standard Lions purposes. Any photograph reproduced will include a photographer credit as feasible. MD308 and LCI will not be required to pay any additional consideration or seek any additional approval in connection with such uses.
7. Judging will be conducted by the professional judges as well as the members of the MD Council 308. Winning photographs will be notified in the respective magazines of the respective Districts. Decisions of the judges will be final and no appeal will be entertained.
8. Prizes will be awarded to the Top 3 entries as follows:-

- 1st Prize – RM1,000 cash + gifts from sponsors
- 2nd Prize – RM400 cash + gifts from sponsors
- 3rd Prize – RM200 cash + gifts from sponsors

Merit awards will also be given out for those photos submitted that are deemed worthy.

9. The winning photo will be submitted by the MD to LCI as the MD's entry to LCI. LCI will display multiple district-level entries at the 95th Lions international convention.
