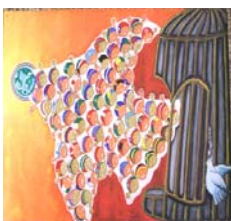
Peace Poster – District 308-B1 Final Selection

Lions wishing to enter the contest should submit an original photo that proudly depicts the environmental where they live to their districts by January 1, 2005. The Multiple District (or single District where no Multiple District exists) then conducts its own contest to select one winning photo to be submitted to Lions Clubs International by March 1, 2005. Winning photos will be displayed at the International Convention in Hong Kong.

Appended below are the Official Contest Rules:

1. One photo entry per club for Lions in good standing only.
2. Photo must be original, unaltered in any way, and have been taken solely for the purpose of this contest. Photos depicting people will be disqualified.
3. Judging of photograph will be held in Muar on 8 January 2005 in conjunction with the 3rd Cabinet Meeting. The decisions of the judges are final and no appeal will be entertained.

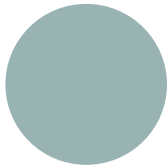
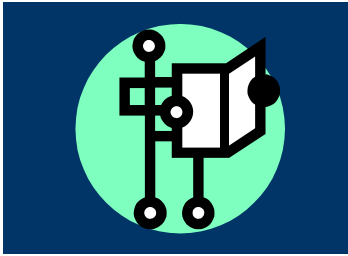
4. No specific sizes of photo for this contest but International are entitled to standardize the size of the photo for framing and exhibiting. Entrants are responsible for all costs in taking and submitting photos.
5. The photo must be based on either one of the five categories:-
 - ✦ Landscapes (urban or natural)

 - ✦ Plant Life
 - ✦ Weather Phenomena
 - ✦ Sharing Our World (this year's special theme)

Each photo submission should include (in one of the official association language i.e. English or Chinese) a Title, the negative, and a 25-word (or less) description of the photo and why the environment being depicted should be improved, protected or preserved.
