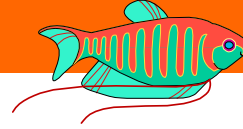

Lions Environmental Photo Contest

Reminder – Have your club members submitted their photo to DC- Environment, Ln Andrew Lim for the Lions Environmental Photo Contest. Deadline for submission is 31st December 2004. The theme is “Sharing our World”.

Contest Rules

1. One photo entry per club for Lions in good standing only.
2. Photo must be original, unaltered in any way, and have been taken solely for the purpose of this contest. Photos depicting people will be disqualified.
3. Judging of photograph will be held in Muar on 8 January 2005 in conjunction with the 3rd Cabinet Meeting. The decisions of the judges are final and no appeal will be entertained.
4. No specific sizes of photo for this contest but International are entitled to standardize the size of the photo for framing and exhibiting. Entrants are responsible for all costs in taking and submitting photos.
5. The photo must be based on either one of the five categories:-
 - a. Landscapes (urban or natural)
 - b. Animal Life
 - c. Plant Life
 - d. Weather Phenomena
 - e. Sharing Our World (this year’s special theme)
6. Each photo submission should include (in one of the official association language i.e. English or Chinese) a Title, the negative, and a 25-word (or less) description of the photo and why the environment being depicted should be improved, protected or preserved.
7. You may use Digital Camera or Traditional Camera with negative. For Digital camera, the jpg file may be sent via email if the size does not exceed 5 MB. If the .jpg file is larger than 5MB, it must be saved to a CD or disc and sent to Ln Andrew Lim via Surface Mail.

Peace Poster Contest



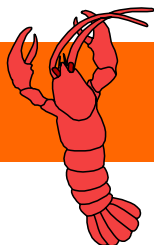
