Extract of District Governor's letter dated 10th March 2005 on certain changes made by the Council of Governors to the 43rd MD 308 Lions Convention 2005 to be held in Malacca from 14th to 17th April 2005.

1. **That all Lions attending the Convention must be registered delegates.** In the past many Lions did not register themselves as a delegate of the Convention, but only attend the Fellowship and Banquet Dinners in the evening only.
2. **The MD Council has endorsed that only REGISTERED DELEGATES can enjoy the activities and programs of the Convention.** Admission to all functions will strictly be by name tags only.
3. **The MD felt that more fellowship is needed in the MD (i.e. sub districts A1, A2, B1 and B2) and therefore this year the Fellowship and Banquet dinners are join together.**

In view of this, NO PRESENTATION OF CLUB AWARDS WILL BE ALLOWED ON THE FELLOWSHIP AND BANQUET DINNERS.

This is the amended guidelines for Leo Club Awards for 2004/2005.

Category 1

- ❖ Submission of Monthly M&A Report and Club accounts by 5th of the following month.
- ❖ Club Election before 30th day of April 2004.
- ❖ Submission of Form Leo 72 to LCI and District on or before 15th May 2004.
- ❖ Installation of President and Board of Directors held not later than 30th September 2004.
- ❖ One Major Service Activity.
- ❖ Attendances at Club Monthly General Members & Board of Directors Meetings are over 60%.
- ❖ Members' attendance at Orientations/Seminars/Workshops/YES Program organized at Club/Zone/Region/District Level.
- ❖ Members' attendance at District 308-B1 YES Camp.
- ❖ Club President/Secretary/Treasurer attended Club Officers School.
- ❖ Club President/Secretary or Treasurer to attend (**registered**) Leo Forum 2005.
- ❖ Publish at least 2 Club Bulletin or 1 Club Leo Handbook.

Category 2

A. Club President

- ❖ Club must fulfill Category 1 requirements.
- ❖ Comply with duties as specified in the Leo Club Officers Manual.
- ❖ Attend at least 1 School for President or Leadership Seminar/Workshop.
- ❖ Attend Leo Forum 2005 (**Registered**).
- ❖ Active participation at Zone/Region/District projects or activities.
- ❖ Attend 90% of all Club Monthly General Members & Board of Directors Meetings.

B. Club Secretary

- ❖ Club must fulfill Category 1 requirements.
- ❖ Comply with duties as specified in the Leo Club Officers Manual.
- ❖ Attend at least 1 School for Secretary or Leadership Seminar/Workshop.
- ❖ Attend Leo Forum 2005 (**Registered**)
- ❖ Active participation at Zone/Region/District Project or activities.
- ❖ Timely submission of Monthly M&A Reports and Form Leo 72.

C. Club Treasurer

- ❖ Club must fulfill Category 1 requirements.
- ❖ Comply with duties as specified in the Leo Club Officers Manual.
- ❖ Attend at least 1 School for Treasurer or Leadership Seminar/Workshop.
- ❖ Attend Leo Forum 2005 (**Registered**)
- ❖ Active participation at Zone/Region/District Project or Activities.
- ❖ Timely submission of Monthly Accounts.

Category 3

A. Outstanding Community Service Award

To be awarded to clubs with the outstanding and meaningful services with majority membership

participation and taking into account of public participation, number of man-hour spent, funds expended and number of people benefited.

B. Outstanding School Service Award

To be awarded to clubs with outstanding and meaningful services extended to school with majority membership participation and taking into account of number of man-hour spent, funds expended and number of students benefited.

C. International Understanding Award

For clubs participating actively towards the promotion of International Understanding through interaction with Leos and/or Lions from other Districts and/or foreign countries.

D. Club Twinning Award

For the participating clubs.

E. Information Technology Award

To be awarded to clubs with the modern information technology skills apply with the clubs activities and maintenance of club website.

F. Fund Raising Award

To be awarded to clubs carrying out meaningful and successful fund raising activities.

G. Club Bulletin Award

To be awarded to clubs producing bulletins or handbooks on Leo's information regularly.

H. Leadership Skills

To be awarded to clubs which have successfully organized seminar/workshops/camps or any other projects that enhances leadership skills.

I. Most Innovative Project Award

For clubs carrying out the most innovative project in term of creativity, originality, uniqueness and beneficial to the larges or specific section of the community.

J. Top Academic Achievement Award

For individual Leos who achieved best overall SPM/STPM result for the year 2004.

K. District Governor Environmental Project Award

For a Leo Club that has carried an environmental project in terms of benefit and effect to the environment.

Category 4

A. Outstanding Leo Member Award

For the sponsoring Lions Club President to recognize one (1) outstanding Member of the Leo Club (excluding Club Presidents, Secretaries and Treasurers)

B. District Governor's Certificate of Appreciation

For Leo Club Presidents, Leo Clubs Secretaries and Leo Treasurers in appreciation of their contribution towards the club while under their leadership. This award is also for all Leo Advisors, Faculty Advisors and School Principals (where applicable) for their guidance and supervision. **Excludes Presidents, Secretaries & Treasurers who have received the Top and Outstanding Awards.**
